Disney Dining Plan meals and snacks may not be redeemed for cash in whole or in part, sold separately, transferred or refunded. Theme Park admission is required for some dining locations. Advance Reservations are strongly recommended and may be required at some restaurants participating in the Disney Dining Plan. Operating hours, menus, entertainment, Characters, Disney Dining Plan locations, components and terms are subject to change without notice.

Disney Dining Plan meal and snack entitlements are based on the length of your package stay at your *Disney Resort* Hotel. The owners of the *Walt Disney World*® Resort shall not be responsible for the non-utilization of package components due to refurbishing, capacity, inclement weather, or any circumstance beyond their control.



Welcome to the Disney Dining Plan,

which offers a convenient and affordable way to enjoy snacks and meals at over 100 select restaurants throughout *Walt Disney World*® Resort, including some restaurants that feature Disney Character Dining! From contemporary to casual, elegant to enchanting, you can find a great meal that fits your style. This brochure outlines the details of what is included and how to use the Disney Dining Plan.

Number of Meals During Your Package Stay

The Disney Dining Plan includes one (1) Quick-Service Meal, one (1) Snack, and one (1) Table-Service Meal per person, per night of your package stay for everyone in the party ages 3 and over.

Using Your Meals

- Use your meals and snacks in any order throughout your package stay until your total is depleted.
- All unused meals and snacks expire at midnight on your package reservation checkout date.

GREAT TIP!

You can continue using meals/snacks in any order during your package stay until each person has depleted his/her allotted meals/snacks. For example, if you use all your snacks on the first day, that will leave zero snacks for the remainder of your stay.

- Over 100 select Quick-Service and Table-Service restaurants, including our legendary Disney Character Dining, participate in the Disney Dining Plan.

Our Table-Service restaurants, character dining and dinner shows book quickly and the restaurant and seating of your choice may be limited or may not be available during your visit. Please make reservations online at disneyworld.com/dining or by calling 407-WDW-DINE up to 180 days prior to your visit for the best options.

Most Quick-Service locations, outdoor food carts and merchandise locations selling frozen ice cream novelties, popcorn, or Coca-Cola® products accept your Disney Dining Plan. Just look for this symbol.



Redeeming Your Meals

- 🐻 Present your Key to the World card to the server or cashier at the time a meal or snack is purchased and specify the number of meals or snacks being redeemed for Guests ages 10+ on your Disney Dining Plan and the number of meals or snacks being redeemed for Guests ages 3-9 on your Disney Dining Plan.
- 🐻 You may **not** redeem meals or snacks for any Guests who are not on your Disney Dining Plan.



GREAT TIP!

When dining with another party who is also using their Key to the World card to redeem their meals, please notify the server which meals should be redeemed on each card.

- 🐻 The following are some of the items **not** included in the Disney Dining Plan:
 - Alcoholic beverages and some bottled drinks
 - Souvenir or refillable drink mugs
 - Snacks and beverages from recreation rental counters
 - Glow Cubes
 - Merchandise and Photo Imaging
- 🐻 **Gratuities are not included unless otherwise indicated.** An automatic 18% gratuity charge will be added to your bill for parties of 6 or more. An automatic gratuity charge may also be added to your bill for items you order that are not included in the Disney Dining Plan (e.g. alcoholic beverages).
- 🐻 The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Tracking Your Meals

- 🐻 Your meal usage will be tracked electronically to your package reservation.

The example below illustrates a party with 2 Guests ages 10+ and 2 Guests ages 3-9 utilizing one of their Quick-Service meal entitlements:

GREAT TIP!

Each time you redeem meals or snacks from your Disney Dining Plan, the server or cashier will provide you with a receipt showing the meals and snacks remaining on your Disney Dining Plan. You can also contact your hotel concierge at any time for your meal plan balance.



Quick-Service Meals

Each Quick-Service Meal includes one (1) single serving:

FOR BREAKFAST

- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage

FOR LUNCH/DINNER

- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Dessert
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage

The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.



Snacks

Some examples of eligible Snack options include:

- ☛ Frozen Ice Cream Novelty, Popsicle or Fruit Bar
- ☛ Single Piece of Whole Fruit
- ☛ 20 oz. Bottle of Coke®, Diet Coke®, Sprite® or 20 oz. Dasani® Water
- ☛ 12 oz. Coffee, Hot Chocolate, or Hot Tea
- ☛ Popcorn Scoop (single-serving box)
- ☛ Single-serving Bag of Snacks
- ☛ 22 oz. Fountain Soft Drink
- ☛ Single-serving Prepackaged Milk or Juice

You may redeem your snacks at most Quick-Service restaurants, outdoor food carts and merchandise locations selling frozen ice cream novelties, popcorn or Coca-Cola® products throughout the Walt Disney World® Resort.



Table-Service Meals

Each Table-Service Meal includes one (1) single serving:

FOR BREAKFAST

- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage



- ☛ One (1) full buffet

FOR LUNCH/DINNER

- ☛ Appetizer (Guest ages 3-9 only)
- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Dessert
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage



- ☛ One (1) full buffet

Advance reservations are strongly recommended. **Gratuities are not included.** The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.



Character Dining

The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Character Dining experiences. One (1) Table-Service meal for each person participating in the Character Dining experience will be redeemed from your meal plan balance, unless otherwise noted. **Gratuities are not included.**

Please Note: Two (2) Table-Service meals for each person dining at *Cinderella's Royal Table* will be redeemed from their meal plan balance. **Gratuities are included.**

Advance reservations are strongly recommended. Merchandise or photo imaging products that may be offered at Character Dining experiences are not included, except at *Cinderella's Royal Table* and *Akershus Royal Banquet Hall*. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.



Signature Restaurants

Disney Signature Restaurants provide unparalleled cuisine served in elegant and relaxed surroundings. Choose from a selection of menu offerings, including children's favorites.

Each Signature Restaurant Meal includes one (1) single serving:

- ☛ Appetizer (Guest ages 3-9 only)
- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage
- ☛ Dessert

Two (2) Table-Service meals for each person dining at a Signature Restaurant will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.

Advance reservations are strongly recommended. Gratuities are not included. Dress Code for Signature Restaurants is Resort Casual. Not permitted in dining room: Tank tops, swimsuits or swimsuit cover-ups, hats for gentlemen, cut-offs, or torn clothing of any kind. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.



Dinner Shows

The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Category 2 or Category 3 seating at all Dinner Shows (subject to availability) and Category 1 seating at the 9:30pm Hoop-Dee-Do Musical Revue (subject to availability). Dinner Show experiences include: *Hoop-Dee-Do Musical Revue*, *Mickey's Backyard BBQ* (seasonal), both located at Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort & Campground, or *Disney's Spirit of Aloha Dinner Show* at Disney's Polynesian Resort. Dinner Shows offer family-style dining with live entertainment show performances throughout the meal, themed to the Resort setting.

Show tickets can be acquired through Concierge. **All Dinner Shows require Advance Reservations. Gratuities are included.**

Two (2) Table-Service meals for each person dining at a Dinner Show will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.

Private In-room Dining/Pizza Delivery

Offers the comfort and convenience of dining in your room at select *Disney Resort* hotels.

Each Private In-room Dining Meal includes one (1) single serving:

- ☛ Appetizer (lunch & dinner; Guest ages 3-9 only)
- ☛ Entrée
- ☛ Dessert (lunch & dinner)
- ☛ Non-alcoholic beverage

Each Pizza Delivery meal includes:

- ☛ Two (2) Single-serving non-alcoholic beverages
- ☛ One (1) Pizza entrée item
- ☛ Two (2) Desserts

Two (2) Table-Service meals for each Private In-room Dining meal ordered will be redeemed from each person's meal plan balance.

Two (2) Adult Table-Service meals will be redeemed from your meal plan balance for Pizza Delivery.

Gratuities are included for both. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill. Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.

Haven't made your dining reservations yet? Our Table-Service restaurants, character dining and dinner shows book quickly and the restaurant and seating of your choice may be limited or may not be available during your visit. Please make reservations online at disneyworld.com/dining or by calling 407-WDW-DINE up to 180 days prior to your visit for the best options. Reservations are accepted at most *Walt Disney World*® Table-Service Restaurants, Signature Restaurants, and Character Dining locations. *Advance reservations are strongly recommended* and are required for Dinner Shows and *Grand Gathering Experiences*. An accepted major credit card guarantee is required for reservations at certain locations. Reservations must be cancelled at least 48 hours (6 days for *Grand Gathering Experiences*) before the scheduled seating time or a cancellation charge may be incurred (charge varies by location). Please indicate any food allergies or other health-related dietary restrictions at the time of booking. We are happy to discuss with you and attempt to accommodate your special dietary requests.

If you have eight or more in your party, you can join other *Grand Gathering* parties in select exclusive Disney experiences. **Each experience is operated on select days of the week.** At least eight persons in your party must attend the same experience.

GRAND *gathering* EXPERIENCES*

- **International Dinner and IllumiNations Dessert Reception** – *Epcot*®: **Two (2) Table-Service meals for each person participating in the *Grand Gathering Experience* will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.**
- **Safari Celebration Dinner** – *Disney's Animal Kingdom*® Theme Park: **Two (2) Table-Service meals for each person participating in the *Grand Gathering Experience* will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.**
- **Good Morning Character Breakfast** – *Magic Kingdom*® Park: **One (1) Table-Service meal for each person participating in the *Grand Gathering Experience* will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.**

Gratuities are included. *Experiences are subject to change and cancellation. Experience may be cancelled by Guests up to 6 days prior to experience date without charge for the experience. Reservations required and may be made up to 180 days in advance but no later than 3 days prior to the experience date. Valid theme park ticket required.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I use my Disney Dining Plan to redeem meals for friends or family members who are not included in my reservation or have not purchased a Disney dining plan?

A. Sorry, you may **not** use your Disney Dining Plan to redeem meals for friends or family members who are not included in your reservation or have not purchased a Disney dining plan.

Q. Are reservations required?

A. **Advance reservations are strongly recommended.** Our Table-Service restaurants, character dining and dinner shows book quickly and the restaurant and seating of your choice may be limited or may not be available during your visit. Please call 407-WDW-DINE or go online to disneyworld.com/dining to make reservations up to 180 days prior to your visit for the best options. Reservations are accepted at most *Walt Disney World*® Table-Service restaurants, Signature Restaurants, and Character Dining locations. Advance reservations are required for Dinner Shows and *Grand Gathering Experiences*.

Q. How do I make reservations?

A. Just call Disney Dining at **407-WDW-DINE** (407-939-3463) or go online to disneyworld.com/dining. An accepted major credit card guarantee is required for reservations at certain locations. Reservations must be cancelled at least 48 hours (6 days for Grand Gathering Experiences) before the scheduled seating time or a cancellation charge may be incurred (charge varies by location). Please indicate any food allergies or other health-related dietary restrictions at the time of booking. We are happy to discuss with you and attempt to accommodate your special dietary requests.

Q. Can Guests ages 3-9 order anything off the menu?

A. No, Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu, where available. Many children's menus offer healthy options in addition to kid favorites. The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill.

Q. Can Guests ages 10+ use Guests ages 3-9 meal entitlements?

A. Sorry, meal entitlements cannot be shared between Guests ages 10+ and Guests ages 3-9.

Q. Must I use exactly 1 Table-Service, 1 Quick-Service and 1 Snack each night of my package stay?

A. No, for maximum flexibility, meal entitlements can be used whenever you like during your package stay. For example, one night you may wish to hold off using a Table-Service meal and then the following night use 2 Table-Service meals to dine at a Signature Restaurant or Dinner Show (subject to availability).

Q. Are gratuities included?

A. No, gratuities are **not** included unless otherwise indicated. An 18% gratuity will be added automatically for parties of 6 or more. A gratuity may also be added automatically for ordered items that are not included in the Disney Dining Plan (e.g. alcoholic beverages).

Q. How will I be able to keep track of the number of meals used?

A. After you dine, your party's remaining meals for that meal type (Table-Service, Quick-Service or Snack) will be printed on the receipt. You can also stop by the Concierge of your hotel for a complete printout of meals used/available.

Q. Do any restaurants have a dress code?

A. Yes, the following Signature Restaurants have a resort casual dress code:

- 🍷 *California Grill* at Disney's Contemporary Resort
- 🍷 *Citricos* at Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa
- 🍷 *Flying Fish Cafe* at Disney's BoardWalk
- 🍷 *Jiko – The Cooking Place* at Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge
- 🍷 *Narcoossee's* at Disney's Grand Floridian Resort & Spa
- 🍷 *Yachtsman Steakhouse* at Disney's Yacht and Beach Club Resorts

Men: Dress slacks, jeans, trousers, or dress shorts, short- or long-sleeved shirt with a collar or t-shirt required. Jackets are optional.
