Welcome to the Disney Dining Plan, which offers a convenient and affordable way to enjoy snacks and meals throughout the *Walt Disney World*® Resort, including many located in the *Downtown Disney*® Area. That means lots of great dining opportunities for you and your family. This brochure outlines the details of what is included and how to use the Disney Dining Plan.

Number of Meals During Your Package Stay
 The Disney Dining Plan includes one (1) Quick-Service Meal, one (1) Snack, and one (1) Table-Service Meal per person, per night of your package stay for everyone in the party ages 3 and over. The plan also includes one (1) Rapid Fill Resort refillable drink mug per person, that is valid for the length of your stay (eligible for refills at self-service beverage islands at Quick-Service locations at any *Disney Resort* Hotel).

Using Your Meals
 You can redeem more than one Quick-Service meal, Table-Service meal or snack per day, if you wish, until your total number of meal/snack entitlements are depleted.

All unused meals and snacks and the ability to use your Rapid Fill Resort refillable mug expire at midnight on your package reservation checkout date.

Finding Dining and Snack Locations
 Most of the restaurant locations in Disney Theme Parks, Disney Water Parks, the *Downtown Disney*® Area and Disney Value, Moderate, Deluxe and Deluxe Villa Resort hotels accept the Disney Dining Plan (please see list of participating restaurants on reverse).

You can also find plenty of locations where you can redeem your Snacks - just look for this symbol  on the menu boards at Quick-Service restaurants, most outdoor food carts and select merchandise locations to identify what is eligible as a Snack.

Please Note: Certain items are not included in the Disney Dining Plan such as:
 • Alcoholic Beverages
 • Items that are more than a single serving (such as a box of doughnuts or a jar of peanut butter)
 • Items (such as popcorn or drinks) that are served in a Souvenir Container
 • Items that are sold from Recreation Rental Counters
 • Items that are considered Merchandise (such as Bottle Toppers, Glow Cubes and Bottle Straps)
 • Special Dining Events with special menus offered at certain Table-Service locations

Redeeming Your Meals
 Present your Resort valid ID (either a *MagicBand* or Key to the World card) to the server or cashier at the time a meal or snack is purchased and **specify the number of meals or snacks being redeemed** for Guests ages 10+ on your Disney Dining Plan and the number of meals or snacks being redeemed for Guests ages 3-9 on your Disney Dining Plan.

- Guests ages 3-9 must order from a children's menu where available.
- Gratuities are not included except at Dinner Shows, Private In-Room Dining and Cinderella's Royal Table.**
 - An additional form of payment is needed if you add a gratuity and have not provided a credit card at check-in to charge incidentals and other expenses to your room.
 - An 18% gratuity will automatically be added to your bill for parties of 6 or more.
 - An automatic gratuity charge may also be added to your bill for items you order that are not included in the Disney Dining Plan (e.g. alcoholic beverages).

Choosing items from a separate prix fixe menu offered at certain locations requires payment of a surcharge in addition to redeeming the number of Table-Service entitlements required at the location.

You may **not** redeem meals or snacks for any Guests who are not on your Disney Dining Plan.

The Disney Dining Plan is unavailable for Guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge, or a meal may be purchased from the menu. The price of the meal will be added to your bill.

Tracking Your Meals
 Your meal usage will be tracked electronically to your reservation. The example below illustrates a party with 2 Guests ages 10+ and 2 Guests ages 3-9, staying on a three-night/four-day package utilizing one of their Quick-Service meal entitlements.


Number of Guests in Party		Total Quick - Service Meals	- Number of Meals Redeemed	= Remaining Quick Service Meals
2 Guests ages 10 and over:	Quick-Service Meals	6	2	4
2 Guests ages 3-9:	Quick-Service Meals	6	2	4
Total:		12	4	8

After you dine, your party's remaining entitlements for the meal type you just enjoyed (Table-Service, Quick-Service or Snack) will be printed on the receipt.

You can also contact your hotel concierge at any time for your meal plan balance.

Healthy Food Options
 Disney is committed to offering a wide range of options for you and your family. We offer menu selections for all of our Guests, including children, seeking well-balanced meals, snacks and beverages as well as those with lifestyle dining requests or special dietary requests. Guests should notate any special dietary requests at the time of booking their dining reservation. Guests may also speak with a chef or manager upon arrival at the dining location.

Snacks

Look for this symbol  on the menu boards at Quick-Service restaurants, most outdoor food carts and select merchandise locations to identify eligible snack options.

NOTE: *Items such as a Hot Dog, Corn Dog or Cereal with Milk are Quick-Service meals and do not qualify as Snacks.*


- Some examples of eligible Snack options include:
- Frozen Ice Cream Novelty, Popsicle or Fruit Bar
 - Popcorn Scoop (single-serving box)
 - Single Piece of Whole Fruit
 - Single-serving Bag of Snacks
 - 12 oz. Coffee, Hot Chocolate, or Hot Tea
 - Single-serving Prepackaged Milk or Juice
 - 20 oz. Bottle of Coke®, Diet Coke®, Sprite® or 20 oz. Dasani® Water
 - 20 oz. Fountain Soft Drink

 Offers the comfort and convenience of dining in your room at select *Disney Resort* Hotels.

Each Private In-Room Dining Meal includes one (1) single serving:

- Entrée
- Dessert (lunch & dinner)
- Non-alcoholic beverage

Two  Table-Service meals for each Private In-Room Dining meal ordered will be redeemed from each person's meal plan balance. **Gratuities are included.**

- Two (2) Desserts


A total of two (2) Adult Table-Service meals will be redeemed from your meal plan balance for each Pizza Delivery meal. **Gratuities are included.**

The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Character Dining experiences. One (1) Table-Service meal for each person participating in the Character Dining experience will be redeemed from their meal plan balance, unless otherwise noted. **Gratuities are not included.**

Please Note: Two  Table-Service meals for each person dining at *Cinderella's Royal Table* will be redeemed from their meal plan balance. **Gratuities are included.**

Merchandise or photo imaging products that may be offered at Character Dining experiences are not included, except at *Cinderella's Royal Table* and *Akershus Royal Banquet Hall*.

The Disney Dining Plan can be used for Category 2 or Category 3 seating at all Dinner Shows (subject to availability) and Category 1 seating at the 8:30pm Hoop-Dee-Do Musical Revue (subject to availability).

Please pick up your dinner show ticket at the Concierge Desk in your *Disney Resort* Hotel prior to arriving at the show. **All Dinner Shows require Advance Reservations. Gratuities are included.**

Two  Table-Service meals for each person dining at a Dinner Show will be redeemed from their meal plan balance.


Two  Table-Service meals for each person dining at a Signature Restaurant will be redeemed from their meal plan balance. **Gratuities are not included.**

Dress Code for Signature Restaurants is Resort Casual. Not permitted in dining room: Tank tops, swimsuits or swimsuit cover-ups, hats for gentlemen, cut-offs, torn clothing of any kind, or t-shirts with offensive language and/or graphics.

Some Great Tips!

Our Table-Service restaurants, character dining and dinner shows book quickly and the restaurant and seating of your choice may be limited or may not be available during your visit. **Please make reservations online at disneyworld.com/dining or by calling 407-WDW-DINE up to 180 days prior to your visit for the best options.**

When dining with another party who is also using their *MagicBand* or Key to the World card to redeem their meals, please notify the server which meals should be redeemed on each Resort ID upon ordering dessert.

Most Quick-Service locations, outdoor food carts and merchandise locations selling frozen ice cream novelties, popcorn, or Coca-Cola® products accept your Disney Dining Plan. Just look for this  symbol to identify eligible snack options.

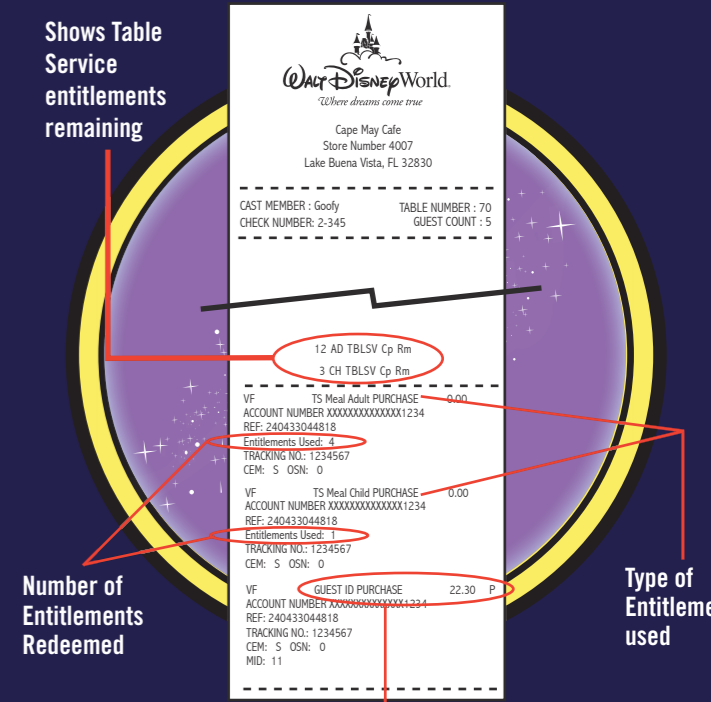
You can continue using meals/snacks in any order during your package stay until each person has depleted his/her allotted meals/snacks. For example, if you use all your snacks on the first day, that will leave zero snacks for the remainder of your stay.

SAMPLE RECEIPT:
